**Background**

Mr. Emad Eassa brings over thirty years of experience in law enforcement to ECC. Presently, Mr. Eassa serves as the Director of Public Safety/Chief of Police with the Forest Preserve District of Kane County. Prior to this position, he was the District Commander for Illinois State Police District 2 in Elgin, which is ranked as the fourth largest of the 21 state police districts. He also was a city patrol officer for the Joliet Police Department. Finally, Mr. Eassa has worked in public safety at both Moraine Valley Community College and Western Illinois University.

Mr. Eassa earned a Bachelor of Science Degree in Law Enforcement Administration from Western Illinois University, and a Master of Science Degree in Criminal Justice from Lewis University. Further, he has participated in specialized training programs resulting in numerous certifications.
