

## Sample Annual\* International Student Budget

It is necessary and required by the U.S. government that international students provide financial proof of their ability to meet the estimated costs of attending ECC. The following is a *sample* budget provided for you to help understand the breakdown of educational costs at ECC. All figures are quoted in U.S. dollars and subject to change.

International student processing fee	\$50
Tuition/fees	\$ 11,350**
Books	\$ 1,500
Room & board	\$0 (If living with relative/sponsor)***
	\$4,875 (If not living with relative/sponsor)+
Transportation	\$ 1,706 ++
Personal expenses	\$ 2,226
Total	\$16,832 (If living with relative/sponsor)
	\$21,707 (If not living with relative/sponsor)

*	Two semesters, not including summer session.
**	Based on 12 credit hours per semester at \$472.46 per credit hour plus student-to-student grant and any applicable lab or course fees. A tuition increase may apply annually.
***	If you will live with relatives or a sponsor, it is not necessary to certify money for room and board. However, your relatives or sponsor will be required to verify your residence.
+	ECC does not provide housing or dormitory space. Information on local apartment rentals may be obtained from the Student Services Manager or the classified sections of local newspapers such as the <u>Daily Herald</u> and <u>Courier News</u> .
++	Transportation to and from campus is the student's responsibility. The college is serviced by bus service; however, most students choose to commute by automobile.
